A Word from Paul Walker

As Christie and I were breaking down an extra crib at Church to give to a family in need, I was struck once again with the ludicrousness of the Son of God's mean birth. As we sing every year, *"away in a manger, no crib for his bed, the little Lord Jesus lay down his sweet head."*

No crib for his bed – not even the basic and elemental security and comfort we take for granted, even from the beginning. According to Jesus, things didn't really get much better in this department throughout his life. He said, *"Foxes have holes, and birds of the air have nests, but the Son of Man has nowhere to lay his head."*

The ironies of the Christmas story shimmer anew each year. As we read in John's prologue, *"He was in the world, and the world was made through him, yet the world did not know him. He came to his own, and his own people did not receive him."* Not only did his own people not receive him, there was literally no room for him in the inn. The One *"from whom every family in heaven and earth receives its name"* was born out of wedlock. The first witnesses of the event longed for by the kings and prophets of old were animals and shepherds, out in the middle of nowhere.

These Christmas ironies, ironies that began the life of a carpenter who died on a wooden cross, a King who stripped off his robes and washed his disciples' feet, a God who won life for us by losing his own. Maybe this Christmas you might see your own ironies – the deepest satisfactions in giving rather than getting, a look of love from an unexpected corner, the Spirit of Christmas stealing upon you unawares.

*How silently, how silently the wondrous gift is given. No ear may hear his coming, but in this world of sin, where meek souls will receive him still, the dear Christ enters in.*

## 2012 Stewardship Report

As of December 1st, we have received 228 pledges totaling \$850,921. Thank you! Of those 228 pledges, 31 are new. These new pledges are a wonderful reflection of the growth God has given us at our church. The Vestry has calculated that we will need a minimum of \$930,000 in pledge income for the General Budget they have set of \$1,163,810. In addition to the pledge income we receive during the course of a year, donations come in through loose plate offerings, non-pledged income, trust income, donations for flowers, etc. This helps to make up the difference between the pledge income and the set budget goal. If you have not pledged, please prayerfully consider doing so.

**Directions:** Head southeast on Route 250 East toward Shadwell Station Lane. Take the first right onto Co Rd. 729/N Milton Rd. Turn left onto Co Rd. 729/Milton Rd. ### The Chancel Renovation:

The dust wall is down and the chancel floor framing is complete. R.E. Lee is still on schedule to complete their work (installation

of the hardwood floor, placement of the new reredos, installation of the new pulpit and communion rail) by Feb. 3<sup>rd</sup>.

### Nave/Narthex Renovation:

- The painting is completed in the Nave. As of this printing, only narthex and west entry vestibule ceilings remain.
- The hardwood flooring is fully installed and stained, sealed and finished.
- Heat pipe leaks that endangered the new oak flooring have been repaired.
- The cleaning subcontractor cleaned the walls, window wells, columns and various other nooks and crannies from all the construction dust!
- The stone flooring has been completed in the Narthex and West Entry Vestibule, and the inset walk-off mat material is installed.
- The carpet on the balcony stairs and in the balcony is installed. The “little” organ will move to the balcony the week of Dec. 12<sup>th</sup>. The same style & color carpeting will be installed in the Meade Hall entry

vestibule and in the hallway to the church after completion of the chancel renovation (early February).

- The piano has been relocated to its “Praise Band” location in the west transept and will be tuned.
- The pews and related kneelers will be installed starting Monday, November 28<sup>th</sup>, and will be completed on or before Friday, December 16<sup>th</sup>. Additional repairs will be performed on some pews as needed during this installation period.
- The center aisle carpet will be installed on Thursday, December 15<sup>th</sup>.
- Final cleaning will occur during the week of December 12<sup>th</sup>.

**Memorial Garden:** Your Senior Warden, Mike Sadler, personally weeded and roto-tilled the entire Memorial Garden. On Saturday, Nov. 19<sup>th</sup>, Hock Hockensmith led a cleanup team to level the ground, remove the weeds and plant an annual rye grass in the Memorial Garden. As soon as R.E. Lee is finished using the alley to the new blower/mechanical rooms, the new drainage system will be installed.

## Honduras Mission Trip: March 3-10, 2012

This year Christ Church will once again be partnering with St. James Episcopal Church, Richmond for a week-long mission trip to Honduras. Our trip will revolve around work with and service to Our Little Roses, a home for 60 - 70 girls, ages 2 - 17 for approximately half of each day. This time will be spent connecting with the girls through games, worship, and Bible study. The other half of each day will be spent working at San Jose de La Montana, a squatters' church in Noueva Prima Vera. It is a rock solid congregation, part of the Episcopal Diocese of Honduras. The estimated cost is \$ 1,200 - \$ 1,500, and we need commitments by December 15th. **Prior to and in support of the mission, Vestry member Punkie Feil is leading a drive to ship brand new or almost new toys and clothing for the girls at Our Little Roses. A large box for donations will be placed in the church office. 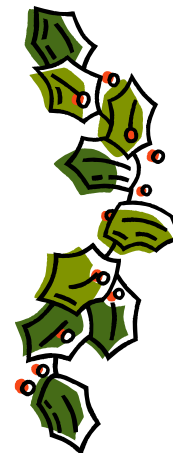
